

## **WEST END BEACH – RULES AND REGULATIONS For Reservations Use**

1. Beach Hours: Weekdays: 9:30 am to 8:30 pm. Weekends: 8:30 am to 8:30 pm.
2. Requests for earlier arrival times must be submitted to the District Office, in writing, at least two weeks in advance. Lifeguards are on duty as scheduled.
3. Parking: Due to limited parking space, buses and other over-sized vehicles may unload passengers at the main entrance, but they must park along Highway 40.
4. Unloading supplies: If you have a large amount of food and equipment to be brought in by one or two vehicles, we will issue a permit which can be obtained by request when submitting your application. The cashier at the main entrance will unlock the gate and allow you to unload in the picnic area. Vehicles must return to the main parking area after unloading is completed.
5. Entering the beach: Please enter through the Main Gate only. Introduce yourself to the Cashier and ask her if she will direct you to the area designated for your group. Your reservation will be posted at your site.
6. Fees: *ADULTS:* \$3.00 *CHILDREN* (17 years & under): \$2.00 *INFANTS:* (UNDER 2): Free.
7. District Season Passes will be honored and may be purchased at the District Office. *Pre-purchased tickets for large groups* may be purchased at the District Office or by mail at least one week prior to the reservation. The District will refund you for any unused tickets if they are returned to us the week after your scheduled activity.
8. Deposits: Cleaning deposits are required from all reserved groups. All groups are responsible for cleaning the area assigned to them. This includes: cleaning tables, and bringing extra plastic trash bags to make your clean-up more efficient. Don't put your deposit in jeopardy! Prior to your departure, ask the cashier or Park Host to check the cleanliness of your area so there is no question about whether or not part of your deposit will be withheld.
9. Safety: Lifeguards have the final authority.
10. No Pets: Seeing Eye Dogs and Service Dogs are the *only* animals allowed on the beach area.
11. Beach Etiquette: All groups are responsible for the actions of their members. Leaders of youth groups are to take an active part in the supervision of their charges. Lifeguards and other personnel cannot be expected to fill-in for chaperones.
12. Recreation Area and Equipment: Volleyball, horseshoe, tennis, basketball, playground and Frisbee areas are all open to the general public and cannot be reserved for special groups.
13. No Glass Containers: Please inform all the members of your group.
14. No Refunds: Due to inclement weather.
15. No Gas Cans: Or Refueling at West End Beach.
16. No Skier Beach starts or drop off: Drop off and starts must take place outside the 5 m.p.h. buoys.
